### Footnotes

NO BIGGIE , showing improved speed, set the pace well off the rail and drew out through the stretch while kept to urging. DROP IT NOW lacked speed, raced in the three path in upper stretch and rallied inside horses. WAQUOIT'S RAVENS lacked speed, was five wide turning for home and had a mild rally between horses. PULLER , checked when pinched back soon after the break, raced six wide turning for home and passed tired foes. TURNING THE TIDE had speed near the rail, swung wide entering the turn, chased the winner to midstretch then faded. NOMAD MAHAR , in the two path on the turn, weakened entering the stretch. BUBBA SYSTEM bore out leaving the starting gate, saved ground around the turn, stopped in upper stretch and was eased the final furlong.
