BEAR'S PROSPECTOR sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and steadily increased his advantage through the stretch while kept to his business. SEATTLE PROSPECT dropped back a bit while wide on the turn, responded in the drive and rallied to narrowly get the place. MENIFEE SIX, angled to the rail entering the turn, saved ground around the bend, swung to the three path in upper stretch and rallied gamely between horses. THE PRINCE chased the pace outside the winner and gave way late. TRIPPLITE circled the turn, chased the pace, drifted wide entering the stretch then gave way near the three sixteenths pole. FARRAGOTS FOLLIES, in the two path on the turn, failed to rally. OUR REPENT was outrun. GRINNELL trailed.
