RHETORICALQUESTION stalked the pace outside FIREY ROCKETTE, overtook that one mid way on the far turn, sprinted clear in upper stretch and prevailed under urging. GREAT MOTION, unruly in the post parade, raced three wide the first turn, dropped back on the far turn, swung very wide in upper stretch and closed late. LEXINGTON PEARL, reluctant to load into the starting gate, was angled to the rail soon after the break, saved ground under patiently handling, eased off the rail on the far turn, awaited room inside the eighth pole then closed gamely between horses. STOLEN DANCE saved ground and lacked the needed late response. VICTORIA'S STRIKE, in the three path between horses entering the stretch, weakened in the drive. MISTRESS QUICKLY, three wide around the far turn, chased the pace to midstretch then weakened. AMAZON QUEEN, wide the first turn, swung very wide in upper stretch and was not a factor. FEISTY ANGELINA had a wide move entering the far turn then gave way. FIREY ROCKETTE showed speed along the rail and faltered.
