Footnotes

RACONTEUR lacked speed, advanced outside horses on the turn, was four wide leaving the bend, closed determinedly under vigorous rousing and was along in the final strides. HAKAMA stalked the pace, circled the turn in the three path, gained a clear lead near the quarter pole then gave way grudgingly. BRIMSTONE ISLAND saved ground in a forward position, lacked room near the five sixteenths pole, swung wide near the three sixteenths pole and rallied gamely. CHARGE lacked speed, floated to the six path near the quarter pole, failed to menace and passed tired rivals. COP A TUDE lacked speed inside horses, swung to the four path near the quarter pole, worked between horses and failed to menace. YO KOFFY sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and gave way in upper stretch. DANGEROUS LAD prompted the pace outside YO KOFFY, was rank near the five eighths pole, remained prominent to the quarter pole then faltered in upper stretch.
