### Footnotes

ENCAUSTIC sped to the early lead, set the pace well off the rail, opened up entering the stretch and was under some urging in midstretch while steadily increasing his advantage. SOLAR FLARE (ARG) , well wide down the backstretch, stalked the pace, circled the far turn when launching a bid, was no match for the winner through the stretch but dug in late to hold the place. EDDIE C. saved ground around the first turn, raced wide on the far turn and failed to sustain his bid. AH DAY saved ground and weakened. NO ADVANTAGE , three wide the first turn, chased the pace, was two wide on the far turn and weakened through the lane.
