PENITANT PRAYERS stalked the pace racing near the rail, eased out on the turn, had a three wide bid for the lead outside OUR SECOND SLEW near the quarter pole, dueled with that one through the lane and narrowly prevailed. OUR SECOND SLEW stalked the pace, gained a two wide lead entering the stretch, dueled through the lane and just missed in a game effort. HOLIDAY BOY, wide entering the stretch, reached a striking position in upper stretch then failed to sustain his bid. CELTIC RED, clear entering the turn, set the pace along the rail and weakened in upper stretch. RANGELEY LITENING, very wide turning for home, failed to rally. TEA TOT saved ground, prompted the pace and gave way in upper stretch. METRO MAN trailed.
