LIGHT MY WORLD settled back off of an early pace scramble, cruised up four wide inside a rival leaving the three eighths pole, responded when shoved on in upper stretch, surged clear in mid stretch and eagerly widened under solid hand encouragement. LOVE THE BREEDING rated forwardly, advanced three wide mid turn, briefly challenged for command in upper stretch, gave hard pursuit of the winner leaving the eighth pole and finished gamely to earn the place outside of GOLDEN SCARF. GOLDEN SCARF took early pressure, moved clear towards the rail nearing the turn, set the pace into the lane, was overtaken nearing the three sixteenths marker and gave way grudgingly. ANDEAN MOON prompted the pace while saving ground, was under pressure into the lane, angled out giving chase inside the eighth pole but went evenly. MAIN ENTRANCE saved ground in range early, was put to a hard drive around the turn, shifted out wide in upper stretch but came up empty. BEYOND MIDNIGHT stalked the pace, made a mild move between runners mid turn, chased in upper stretch and faded. MEDALETTE broke a step slow, was taken four wide early, made a slight move leaving the far turn, drifted wider approaching the lane and gave way.
