Footnotes

SPINNING LADY vied outside rivals early while under rating, moved clear after a quarter mile and dropped in towards the rail, was nursed along around the turn, widened the advantage in mid stretch, remained on her left lead and held sway under a solid drive. STEPH'S BULLET prompted the early issue inside rivals under rating, eased back losing precious ground near the far turn, angled out four wide for the drive, closed willingly once straightened and was getting to the winner. MONSTER SLEEPING , four wide early, stalked three wide around the turn and went evenly in the final furlong. HEAVENLY CHOIR , three wide, was under a solid ride mid turn, shifted out a bit wider in upper stretch but failed to seriously response. SWEET MAXINE pressed between runners early, angled to the rail to give chase around the turn and faded. FOURSOUTHERNBELLES lacked speed, angled five wide approaching the stretch but lacked a rally.
