ANDRUS ATHENA lacked speed, was four deep turning for home, floated to the five path approaching the eighth pole, closed outside horses and drove clear late. CAUTION SIGN prompted the pace four deep around the turn,gained a short lead approaching the eighth pole, drifted out late and gave way grudgingly. HA HA FOOLED YA saved ground setting a pressured pace and weakened the final furlong. MISS GLENGAR prompted the pace two wide between horses and faded in the stretch. VICTORIA'S COMET , two deep on the turn, was not a factor. SCIPION'S GIRL saved ground and came up empty in the stretch. SCORE BOYERA pressed the pace racing in the three path between horses and gave way entering the stretch.
