SUMMER HUSTLER set the pace outside EVIL LAD under confident handling, was set down approaching the eighth pole and eagerly pulled away. CONNOR THE CONCH , fractious in the post parade, raced in the two path on the turn, eased out in upper stretch then offered a mild rally. EVIL LAD bobbed slightly at the break, had speed along the rail and faded the final furlong. ACCEPTANCE LETTER saved ground and was not a factor. WHEELING FEELING circled the turn, raced wide entering the stretch and failed to rally. STAND UP STAN chased the pace, drifted wide in upper stretch then gave way. JACK SEABROOK broke slowly, circled the turn and faltered.
