### Footnotes

SPRINKLESMIDDLE EZ sped to the front, set a fast pace near the rail and was under brisk urging in the stretch. DISTORTED DISCIPLE lacked speed, entered the stretch in the four path and rallied between horses. CROSS MOUNTAIN , void of speed, was very wide leaving the turn and rallied. GREAT CURVES chased the winner three wide and faded in the drive. POPIC , three wide around the turn, was not a factor. ESTANASAMANTHA , inside horses turning for home, was not a factor. POLONEZ was outrun. SECLUDED WAY gave way. CITY TALENT saved ground and gave way. SWINDLER bore out entering the turn, dropped back and was eased.
