YANO sped to the early lead, set the pace along the rail, opened up in midstretch and held sway under urging. PROUD DADDY , a forward factor in the two path, dropped back a bit on the turn, eased out to the three path entering the stretch and rallied late. STRAIGHT THUNDER prompted the pace outside the winner and weakened in the stretch. VOTE YES FOR LOVE circled horses on the turn, floated to the six path entering the stretch then passed tired foes. BERT B DON , between horses in the stretch, passed tired ones. ASHQUAR saved ground and weakened. DIRT DIVER circled the turn three wide, was fanned four deep turning for home, then gave way. MINE N GEMS , wide on the turn, gave way. WIE EIN STEIN hugged the rail and trailed.
