Footnotes

MY ENTICEMENT lacked speed, advanced along the rail entering the turn, drifted out in front GOLD CASTLE near the three eighths pole, took the lead outside horses in upper stretch, was under urging and drew off. ALSTON GUNTER disputed the pace outside SIR DUNCAN and gave way grudgingly in the drive. GOLD CASTLE, in the two path entering the turn, was steadied on the heels of the winner near the three eighths pole, swung wide in upper stretch, remained on his left lead and rallied. BONHEUR, three wide on the turn, rallied between horses. FIDDLERS CHAPARITO, four wide entering the turn, was five wide leaving the turn, floated to the six path in upper stretch and weakened. SWALLOW THE FIELD, wide entering the stretch, floated to the five path in upper stretch and faltered. SIR DUNCAN saved ground, dueled and faltered in upper stretch. An objection by the rider of GOLD CASTLE against the winner for alleged interference on the turn was not allowed.
