HUGHES NEXT prompted the pace two wide, moved to command mid turn, edged clear into the stretch, opened up under stout left handed urging leaving the three sixteenths marker, continued under a strong left hand drive to the sixteenth pole then was under steady hand pressure the final seventy yards. GREEK WARRIOR broke inward hitting the inside portion of the stall and causing his rider to briefly lose his balance, recovered and angled out bumping WHATDOYUSEE near the six and a half furlong pole, moved up three wide between rivals to gain a stalking position, dropped back a bit leaving the far turn, came back four wide into the stretch to loom, continued willingly to the wire and outfinished COUNT TO SEVEN for the place. COUNT TO SEVEN rated within range while off the rail, was lightly steadied behind rivals near the half mile marker, eased out and advanced three wide between rivals nearing the eighth pole, continued on gamely inside of GREEK WARRIOR but was edged for second. WARRENSBURG saved ground while forwardly placed, made a mild advance inside rivals nearing mid stretch then faded in the final fifty yards. WHATDOYUSEE , four wide under rating and off the early pace, exchanged bumps with GREEK WARRIOR near the six and a half furlong marker, trailed while wide past the three eighths pole, circled five wide into the stretch and had no response. BALTO MORE went clear early and set a slow pace, took pressure from the winner into the far turn, dueled inside that one to the head of the lane then tired through the final furlong.
