### Footnotes

THE A. TRAIN hugged the rail, disputed the pace, sprinted clear in upper stretch and was under urging in the drive. AE PIT bobbled soon after the break, circled the turn, floated to the seven path in upper stretch and rallied. BORREGO'S BOY saved ground around the turn, angled out in midstretch and finished willingly. DANGER ANGEL, swung to the six path entering the stretch, passed tired foes. GO SIX GO prompted the pace outside the winner, weakened and drifted in near the three sixteenths pole. CELESTIAL FIELDS prompted the pace two wide to the turn, drifted out leaving the turn and weakened. MONTY'S APPEAL, in the five path in upper stretch, failed to rally.
