Footnotes

DIVERSIFICATION hugged the rail, dropped back when outrun for position leaving the backstretch, continued along the rail, angled out approaching the sixteenth pole, closed and drove clear. FUHR TOWN bobbled slightly at the break, saved ground disputing the pace, opened a clear advantage in midstretch and gave way grudgingly. WILLY'S MONSTER , forwardly placed off the rail, was three wide entering the stretch, drifted in a bit in upper stretch and turned in an even effort. NACHO EARL lacked speed, raced along the rail on the turn, angled outside in midstretch and lacked the needed response. BLITZBALL , well off the rail, was not a factor and passed tired horses. RISKY RIVER , three wide leaving the backstretch, bid for the lead outside FUHR TOWN entering the turn, dueled with that one to upper stretch then gave way the final furlong. ONEWILDRIVER chased the pace four deep leaving the backstretch and faltered on the turn.
