Footnotes

EXCESSIVELYPATIENT dueled between rivals past the five furlong marker, took pressure around the turn, responded to left handed urging to go clear leaving the three sixteenths marker then dug in gamely under stout urging to narrowly prevail. STACKING THE DECK, taken to rate in good position off the contested pace, advanced three wide under urging nearing the stretch, was put to a strong ride near the furlong marker and closed between rivals to just miss. FINGER TAPPING, allowed to settle early, circled four to five wide into the stretch, closed willingly and steadily gained. A FAST REB, outrun early, was put to a ride mid turn while saving ground, angled out some in upper stretch and gained between rivals. BRIDGE TO NOWHERE dueled inside the winner through the opening quarter mile, was rated back nearing the turn, stalked the pace around the turn while saving ground, eased out some in upper stretch, was in a bit close near the furlong marker then closed willingly once clear. HEY MOUTH prompted the pace three wide, lodged a bid under a ride nearing the quarter pole, held well to mid stretch then surrendered. PROMENADES HERO lost his rider leaving the three quarter pole when the rider's left stirrup appeared to break.
