Footnotes

DANDY WALTZ measured INDIO ROOSTER while three wide and under rating, moved in hand to challenge three furlongs out, put a head in front near the quarter pole, dueled under right handed pressure and held sway. INDIO ROOSTER cleared early, set a slow pace in the two path, was joined by the winner leaving the far turn, dueled inside that one from the five sixteenths pole and continued on gamely to the wire. BID TIL INCLUDED settled back early, saved ground into the far turn, shifted out for room in upper stretch and closed steadily through the final furlong. MR. E. rated forwardly while saving ground, was ridden along mid way on the final turn then came up empty. SHOW THE WAY was angled off the rail around the first turn, steadied when working between rivals near the five eighths pole, appeared to be wanting to get in some nearing the far turn, chased the leaders past the five sixteenths pole then gave way in the drive. FIRST NITE settled back well off the rail, made a mild advance five wide leaving the far turn, chased five wide into the lane, gave way and was eased late. SHAWHAN SELECT , in close entering the first turn, moved up three wide between rivals past the five eighths pole, chased briefly then tired after six furlongs.
