Footnotes

BELLAGIO prompted the pace three wide around the turn, gained the lead in midstretch then drove clear late. CLASSIC WILDCAT , in the two path between horses entering the turn, angled to the four path in upper stretch and rallied. SANDBAGIN' LOVER dueled in the two path between horses and weakened late. MR. COMMISSIONER hugged the rail, disputed the pace and weakened the final furlong. PENDULUM , four wide around the turn, chased the pace and faded in upper stretch. SOUTHERN RAINBOW saved ground and was outrun. INDY KRIZZ , in the three path on the turn, was outrun. LORD DUBAI , wide on the turn, dropped back.
