CONCRETE CAT sped to the front, opened up in midstretch and held sway under urging. PENDING ASSET stalked the pace, circled the turn and closed outside horses. CORUNDUM lacked speed, saved ground and rallied inside. FOCUS stalked the pace, worked between horses in the stretch and weakened late. IRUNALATTE worked between horses through the stretch, closed the gap and was steadied in close quarters in deep stretch. DISCO ELVIS , wide on the turn, failed to sustain his bid and drifted wider late. RANDOM PAY CHECK chased the pace, entered the stretch two wide and gave way late. WINNING QUEST was no factor. PATIENCEGRASHOPPER was outrun. An objection by the rider of IRUNALATTE against PENDING ASSET for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed.
