GUILLOTINE moved up along the rail on the far turn, eased out two wide entering the stretch, took command in upper stretch and pulled away with something in reserve. DIABLO'S DEEDS set the pace along the rail, weakened and held the place. RUN MARIA RUN saved ground, dropped back midway on the far turn and passed tired horses in the stretch. BRIT KAY raced three wide between horses midway on the far turn and weakened. SACKVILLE PARADE was outrun. QUARTERS UP raced three wide on the first turn, four wide the far turn and weakened. HARMATTAN was outrun. TURNING LEAF stalked the pace for a half mile and gave way. .
