Footnotes

OUR PEAK , patiently handled, swung five wide in upper stretch, closed determinedly under brisk urging and was along in time. AH DAY stalked the pace, raced wide on the turn, gained a clear advantage in midstretch and continued gamely. SUNSHINE ALPINE raced between horses, was steadied in close quarters near the eighth pole and gained the show. MIKE'SGOODANDTOUGH , very wide in upper stretch, tightened quarters on inside horses when drifting in near the eighth pole then failed to sustain his bid. VEGAS PLAY saved ground on the turn, raced between horses through the stretch and was steadied in tight quarters near the eighth pole. COLBY CAT , shuffled back soon after the start, was not a factor and raced in the six path in the stretch. NOW BATTING , shuffled back early, was no factor. HAPPY SURPRISE sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and gave way in upper stretch. HONEST APPEAL , three wide, chased the pace and was checked in tight quarters between horses near the eighth pole. TACTICAL BRUSH , two wide, chased the pace and gave way. CONNECTICAT , very wide, was outrun.
