Footnotes

CHRISTIAN'S STAR , three wide the first turn, prompted the pace under rating, moved to command leaving the far turn, kicked clear under a light hold near the quarter pole, turned back a challenge from CAJUN QUICKSTEP in mid stretch then kicked back clear under a right handed drive. CAJUN QUICKSTEP rated in good position leaving the five eighths pole, advanced three wide into the stretch, moved to threaten a furlong out while on his left lead, failed to sustain and faded. IMPERIAL GIN lost ground four wide most of the trip, rallied to contention into the lane, finished willingly and earned the show. ALEX IS BACK was angled to the rail soon after the break and allowed to settle, swung out six wide advancing into the stretch, made steady progress leaving the eighth pole then hung late. SHILOH'S PRIDE vied between rivals early, was rated back and stalked the pace inside to the far turn, continued a forward presence to upper stretch then came up empty. WESTEND WILLY raced between rivals to the far turn and failed to respond. HERON COVE set a slow pace inside, duelled nearing the half mile pole, was overtaken three eighths out then faltered in upper stretch.
