INDIANA MOON prompted the pace outside JOHN FRANCIS, gained the lead entering the turn, opened up in midstretch and was kept to his business in the drive. SPICER CUB circled horses three wide on the turn, challenged for the lead entering the stretch, finished gamely but was no match for the winner. TURBIN, a forward factor between horses, was boxed in midway on the turn then closed the gap late between rivals. SUN CATCHER, rated back midway down the backstretch, raced wide leaving the turn and closed the gap late. JOHN FRANCIS showed speed along the rail, was prominent for six furlongs then steadily retreated through the stretch. AVALANCHE ROCK saved ground, steadied lacking room midway on the turn then failed to recover.
