BULLSBAY, unhurried early, was two wide leaving the far turn, angled to the rail in upper stretch, bid for the lead inside the eighth pole and prevailed under brisk urging. SENIOR, between horses on the far turn, swung three wide entering the stretch, gained a short lead in midstretch and continued gamely. ADMIRAL'S CRUISE hesitated at the break, lacked speed, swung wide leaving the far turn and rallied. BRADY BABY prompted the pace outside CRIMSON COMIC, bid for lead entering the stretch, remained prominent to the sixteenth pole and tired in the drive. RICHARD'S KID lacked speed, raced five wide turning for home and passed tired foes. CRIMSON COMIC set the pace along the rail, surrendered entering the stretch and fell back. P V LIGHTENING raced well off the rail, stopped and was eased.
