BAKE SHOP saved ground setting the pace, steadily increased his advantage through the stretch and was under brisk urging in the drive. SABA ROCK lacked speed, swung to the six path in upper stretch, brushed with SENOR QUICKIE near the three sixteenths pole and rallied outside foes. CHARDSEY, three wide on the turn, chased the winner and weakened. IMORATAS, wide around the turn, floated to the seven path turning for home and passed tired foes. CATTAIL CREEK hugged the rail around the turn and in the stretch and came up empty. SENOR QUICKIE saved ground, swung to the four path entering the stretch, brushed with SABA ROCK in upper stretch and gave way. DELIRIOUS TIDE, steadied in traffic near the five eighths pole, swung to the five path in upper stretch then faltered. SARBANES, wide on the turn, dropped back. SAINTS PRESERVE US bobbled at the break, chased the pace two wide and stopped after six furlongs.
