**Footnotes**

BRIMSTONE ISLAND vied outside of BEHEMOTH through the opening quarter mile, disposed of that one nearing the turn and moved away under a light hold, extended his margin entering the stretch, responded to solid handling leaving the quarter pole, remained under pressure to deep stretch then maintained a safe margin while geared down in the final yards. WILD LOUIS , between runners early, angled in making progress into the turn, gave hard pursuit leaving the three eighths pole, angled off the inside for the final three sixteenths and closed gamely in a sharp effort. THUNDER BALL , under a snug hold while off the pace, came two to three wide advancing into the stretch, dropped to the rail leaving the quarter pole and finished with good energy. ASCAUGA , taken to rate three to four wide in range off the winner, came under pressure into the stretch but one paced from there. STAND PROUD , under rating four to five wide, made a slight move mid turn, chased through the lane but lacked a significant finish. HI HO BAMBINO , four wide, lacked a rally. MYSTICAL TERP saved ground early and failed to respond. NO BRAKES , four wide, lacked a bid. TAPPININTOVICTORY saved ground around the turn in a dull effort. BEHEMOTH was sent up leaving the chute, vied inside the winner, eased back a bit when failing to match strides past the five eighths pole, chased around the turn and tired.
