**Footnotes**

DANCIN N' DEALIN hugged the rail around the turn, eased out to the two path in upper stretch, aggressively split horses near the eighth pole, closed outside COTTON WON and was along in time. COTTON WON showed speed three deep leaving the backstretch, gained the lead mid way on the turn, opened up in midstretch then weakened along the rail. PETER'S CREEK , wide around the turn, floated to the six path turning for home and rallied outside foes. DUKES ALLEY , four deep on the turn, rallied mildly. CROSSEYED showed speed along the rail, eased out leaving the turn, was three wide in upper stretch, weakened and drifted out in midstretch. PIANO MAN TED , five deep leaving the turn, finished with interest. HARD ROCK DELITE saved ground on the turn, swung out entering the stretch and was caught in close quarters in midstretch. SON OF THE SUN showed speed in the two path, angled to the rail leaving the turn and gave way in the drive. BRI'S VISION , outrun, swung to the eight path leaving the turn. D' SAUVAGE bumped with FROLIC ON HOME leaving the backstretch then weakened. FROLIC ON HOME bumped with D'SAUVAGE leaving the backstretch and dropped back.
