MILITARY CODE sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside and dug in under a drive. SILVER EMBLEM stalked the winner two to three wide, raced on her left lead late and finished gamely. HAPPY IN PARIS settled early, angled to the inside nearing the far turn, advanced along the rail mid turn, swung out wide for the drive and finished with good energy. YELLOW DIAMOND chased the pace while saving ground and went evenly. HAVIN' A MOAN, away alertly, chased the early pace three wide, dropped back on the turn, continued wide in the drive and lacked a response. INDIAN DESIRE, between rivals near the half mile marker, gave way in upper stretch. FOUFA'S HUNTER, unruly pre race, failed to menace. WHATA RUBY GIRL was not a factor. WITCHY MOON broke slowly, was hustled wide into the turn and failed to threaten.
