DRESS GREY duelled along the rail, opened up on the turn, steadily increased her advantage through the stretch under vigorous rousing and galloped out lame. TEN HALOS , three wide between horses, finished willingly. SUMMER CRUISE stumbled leaving the starting gate, raced wide and lacked the needed rally. GREAT SAINT lacked speed, raced five wide on the turn and passed tired ones. CANTORA raced along the rail and gave way. SEA PINES raced in the two path and was no factor. TRACEABLE , in traffic on the turn, gave way. CANDY ONE gave way. CITICHURCH had speed in the two path, stopped and was eased.
