POMPAMENTO cleared into the turn, set the pace along the inside, opened up a bit nearing mid stretch and held sway under a drive. MINISTEROFTRUCKS , prominent from the start along the inside, angled out in upper stretch and finished gamely. CANBY DANCER , rated back between rivals nearing the turn, circled the turn three wide, gained ground but was outfinished for the place. ALY'S LEADER , three wide between rivals near the three eighths pole, was urged along on the turn, raced wide in the drive and lacked a solid response. MUSTANG GAL angled in early to save ground, lacked a late response. SAVVY GIRL , towards the inside mid turn, failed to respond. IVARS MS MAYHEM , rushed to contention, chased the winner while off the rail and gave way in upper stretch. DEE I DO was outrun. GULF OF GDANSK , four wide, dropped back.
