**Footnotes**

EXCESSIVELYPATIENT dueled on a short lead along the rail while under a rating hold, responded when set down in upper stretch, opened up a clear lead past the three sixteenths marker and widened a bit under a drive. DESTINEDTOBEMINE dueled outside the winner and held well to save the place. PROMENADES HERO rated off the dueling leaders while saving ground, angled out near the three sixteenths pole but went evenly when called upon. STACKING THE DECK , between rivals early, chased the leaders around the turn, came five wide for the drive but lacked a significant response. FINGER TAPPING , four wide early, angled in near the half mile marker, swung back out for the drive and had no rally. SECURITY GUARD lagged back off the rail and failed to menace.
