Footnotes

EDGER settled four wide, steadily advanced four wide nearing the lane, moved to clear advantage approaching the furlong marker, switched to her left lead and held sway under a drive. SECOND DATE broke a step slow, lagged well back early while saving ground, swung out five wide leaving the three sixteenths marker and closed willingly. HANNAH'S MOON set the pace towards the inside, edged away a bit leaving the three eighths pole, was collared in upper stretch, held well to the furlong marker then faded. RINKA BELL saved ground early, swung out six to seven wide nearing the lane and failed to respond. ROBIN'S FLIGHT moved up between rivals nearing the backstretch to gain a stalking position, gained ground nearing the half mile marker, chased the pace three wide nearing the quarter pole then faded. SHE CAN PUNCH, three wide early, angled to the rail nearing the far turn, chased the pace then gave way in the drive. ONEMOREFASHION prompted the pace outside of HANNAH'S MOON for nearly six furlongs then retreated.
