SWEET TALKER stalked the pace two wide, move to contention entering the stretch, opened up under urging in midstretch and prevailed while kept to her business. SMART N CLASSY , angled in approaching the first turn and rallied two wide between horses. HUMORISTIC saved ground stalking the pace, eased out entering the stretch and flattened out between rivals. ART FAN raced inside horses, swung wide entering the stretch and failed to sustain her bid. FIN (GB) raced very wide entering the stretch and passed tired ones. COZY GAIN raced between horses and was no factor. ERNABEL set the pace along the rail and gave way. REGAL APPROACH raced along the rail and passed tired ones. DYNAMIC DEPUTY , wide on the turns, weakened. QUEEN SUPREME , wide on the turns, was outrun. JOYFUL JACKIE , three wide, chased the pace and faltered. FEELIN' THE BREEZE lost ground on the turns and faltered.
