Footnotes

JAZZ was unhurried early, raced wide the far turn, gained the lead in midstretch and lasted. BERTA'S SILVER raced wide entering the stretch and closed gamely. GARDEN SPOT raced in the two path, reached a striking position in midstretch then flattened out. SISTER BERTIE raced wide on both turns, came in near the eighth pole and rallied mildly between horses. EESEE'S LASS moved up two wide to challenge for the lead on the far turn, drifted out in midstretch and weakened. LA SAMANNA was caught in tight quarters entering the first turn, raced inside horses to the stretch and lacked a rally. LITTLE BIG THORN raced wide down the backstretch, led three wide on the far turn and weakened in the stretch. BRITTANY S. disputed the pace along the rail and gave way. FOLLY DOLLAR dueled two wide and gave way.
