LA REINETTE, four wide the first turn, moved up three wide in hand into the far turn drew clear nearing the stretch and pulled away under steady hand pressure. RUSSIAN MARKET, under stout rating towards the inside, angled three wide nearing the quarter pole, lugged in briefly in upper stretch and gained the place. RIKTA, five wide into the first turn, angled to the inside down the backstretch, slipped through along the rail to gain command into the far turn, briefly went clear the final turn then steadily retreated in the drive. IRON SLIPPERS saved ground to the stretch, angled out and offered a mild late response. STRETCH EMOUT went to an early lead, set the pace off the rail to the half mile marker and tired. TOI'S TURK was outrun. MEMORY DANCE dropped back.
