TALI TUBBY passed tired ones. TESTAMONY'S STAR circled the turn and lacked a rally. GOTTTCHA LAST broke slowly and passed faders. COOKIN JEN raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. R. ESS V. P. was no factor. WILLY'S SISTER raced wide and was outrun. LISTENTOTHEBELLS raced off the rail and was no factor. KITTY'S CREEK raced along the rail and was outrun.
