STYLISH STEPPER raced between horses, closed determinedly under strong riding and was along in time while coming out approaching the wire. RHYTHMICAL LADY raced very wide around the turn and missed while brushed by the winner in deep stretch. TIMES A WASTIN raced three wide, gained the lead inside the eighth pole then weakened. PAULINE'S PROSPECT, swung wide at the head of the stretch, passed tired ones. HAMPSHIRE DANCER set the pace in the two path and gave way. JOHNNIE TWELVE, three wide between horses on the turn, lacked a rally. KAYLAS SURPRISE, fractious behind the starting gate, saved ground and gave way. WILD IRISH ROSE saved ground and was no factor. ODDS ON LOVE, steadied and a bit rank in traffic near the half mile pole, raced wide around the turn and dropped back.
