VALAY BULLET pressed the pace two wide, gained command nearing the eighth pole, drifted in twice through the lane and edged clear under a drive. RHODA ELAINE broke sharply, set the pace along the rail and gave way grudgingly. NOT WHAT I DO bobbed leaving the gate, raced two wide and finished willingly between rivals to gain the show. BELLE DE SOLEIL steadied at the start, raced five wide into the turn, continued five wide into the stretch, loomed then hung. HELLOHELLOHELLO prompted the pace three wide, weakened and was in tight in mid stretch. SHES A CAPER TOO saved ground and weakened. BUBBLEOVER, racing without a whip, was sluggish from the gate, raced four wide and dropped back. SONG REQUEST, rank at the start, was taken back, raced wide and was never close.
