Footnotes

PLEASANT BEAU , three wide both turns, secured command approaching the eighth pole then drew off under urging. CHARLES PRIDGEN , shuffled back entering the first turn, saved ground and rallied. PINS 'N NEEDLES , wide the far turn, finished willingly. HIGHCREST , unhurried between horses, was in the four path entering the stretch then passed tired rivals. CADRE lacked speed, raced between horses, angled wide in upper stretch and passed tired foes. ALLERGEE , four wide the first turn, moved up two wide the far turn to prompt the pace, remained prominent to midstretch then weakened. GIRON lacked speed, raced in the six path turning for home and passed tired rivals. OH MY ME MY was not a factor. BAVARIAN , between horses, chased the pace to the far turn then faltered. NIGHTSCAPE , six wide entering the stretch, gave way. OUT OF OUR MINE set the pace off the rail and faltered in upper stretch.
