**Footnotes**

NIGHT Q disputed the pace five deep entering the turn, dropped in some nearing the three eighths pole, moved to command mid turn, edged clear approaching the stretch, widened some nearing mid stretch then was fully extended to prevail. HEY DOC HOLIDAY , unhurried early after a bit of a slow beginning, circled six wide into the stretch and finished up well. DE CHERA dueled two wide between rivals into the turn, held a short lead after a half mile, chased the winner into the stretch and continued on with interest. BUSTER DOUGLAS , well placed towards the inside while off of contested pace, came up empty. OUTQUEST settled back early, raced between rivals in upper stretch, angled in and lacked a solid response. BIG BOPER vied four wide between rivals nearing the turn, chased the leaders mid turn while three to four wide then weakened in upper stretch. THE INTINIDATOR , five to six wide into the turn, failed to respond. PROBATE , within range six wide past the five eighths pole, dropped back after a half mile. OLD LINE STATE held a short lead three wide between rivals early, chased the leaders around the turn and weakened. PEACEFUL DOVE was sent up inside early to contest the pace, forced the issue for nearly a half mile then tired.
