Footnotes

TIME FOR TUTT lacked speed, raced wide turning for home, closed and quickly drew out late. CHECKS CASHED stalked the pace, circled the far turn, gained the lead approaching the eighth pole and weakened in the drive. DEVIL OF A DEAL , wide the far turn, flattened out between horses. UNION CHAPEL ROAD , sent to the front, set the pace near the rail and weakened the final furlong. TUXEDO PARK saved ground and weakened. SUMMER HUSTLER , wide the first turn, dropped back down the backstretch and failed to be a late factor. PASS ON THE RIGHT lacked speed and was not a factor. BREMO'S BLUFF , outrun, raced very wide around the far turn. DESERTION , very wide leaving the backstretch, gave way. ARGENT ET ROMEO , steadied on the heels of ADAM'S TURN entering the first turn, was outrun. POLISH DISCO , three wide, was rank on the first turn, prompted the pace and

faltered. ADAM'S TURN bolted entering the first turn and was pulled up on the backstretch.
