### Footnotes

BREEZY BOY moved up three wide in hand nearing the turn, tracked the dueling leaders three wide mid turn, moved to challenge into the lane, responded to left handed pressure to take command a furlong out, edged clear nearing the sixteenth marker and held sway under strong handling. ROBBING THE BANK lost ground four wide while outrun early, commenced a rally leaving the three sixteenths pole, worked his way between rivals through the final furlong and finished with good energy. COTTON BROOK ROAD saved ground early while within range, eased out leaving the three eighths pole, moved between rivals after a half mile, angled out five wide for the drive and continued on willingly. LUNAR PASS moved up outside to challenge into the turn, dueled under rating while holding a short lead mid turn, was collared into the stretch, battled past the furlong marker and gave way grudgingly. BOXER SHORTS stalked the pace while saving ground and came up empty. HOUSTON BULL lost ground four to five wide chasing the pace and failed to respond. NOT MY PROBLEM was away awkwardly, taken to rate early, raced between rivals in upper stretch and failed to rally. FUNNY BOOK broke slowly, saved ground leaving the three eighths pole and was outrun. WANNALOTTALOVIN' cleared early and angled in, was joined into the turn, dueled once headed past the three eighths pole, continued a forward presence to the lane then faltered.
