WOLF TALK raced wide around the turn, closed steadily and was up in time. SIR WEXFORD wide around the turn, angled out upper stretch and closed. ONE MORE POWER saved ground, dueled, opened up in midstretch and weakened. SYLVESTER QUESTOR saved ground, angled out in midstretch and finished willing between horses. GASTON raced three wide for most of the trip and lacked the needed rally. COASTAL TYDE well placed behind horses, faded in the drive. MOSARL PZAR saved ground, angled wide for drive and failed to menace. NORTHEASTOF ATHENS dueled two wide and fell back. ALLEN GORGEOUS rank leaving the starting gate, was outrun. P. A.'S IRON MAN bore out badly entering the turn and stopped.
