ADMIRAL'S PRIDE, unhurried between horses, swung wide in midstretch, closed determinedly and was along in time. STORM DANCER stalked the pace near the rail, was steadied when blocked in midstretch, found room and rallied gamely. PERFECTLY CHILLED stalked the pace near the rail, swung out in upper stretch and faded. SHE'S RAPID dueled three wide and weakened. SALEM COUNTY saved ground and passed tired ones. SAY VICTORY disputed the pace racing along the rail and gave way. IN THE GLEN, wide, failed to rally. GRACIOUS BREVITY, no factor, raced very wide in the stretch. GINA'S ACTRESS bore out leaving the starting gate and was outrun. PETE'S FLAIR, wide, was steadied in close quarters approaching the eighth pole. LISTENING FR WINGS, outrun, raced extremely wide. CATE'S ROSE dropped back.
