Footnotes

REGAL MIRACLE , four wide the first turn, prompted the pace three wide under rating down the backstretch, took a short lead three furlongs out, dueled briefly, kicked clear in upper stretch and held sway under a drive. CAJUN SOUP rated close up while saving ground, angled out leaving the far turn, advanced three wide into the lane, drifted out a bit in mid stretch and chased the winner home in willing fashion. MY SPOT , forwardly placed while off the rail, was hustled along around the final turn then came up empty through the final furlong. WARM UP angled off the rail in early backstretch, lodged a bid between rivals mid way down the backstretch, dueled past the three furlong marker then tired leaving the eighth pole. ROLLING INTO TOWN was outrun. COUNTY RECOUNT cleared early, set a slow pace along the inside, took pressure five furlongs out, was put to strong urging near the half mile marker then faltered after six and a half furlongs.
