Footnotes

PETER'S CREEK broke a step slow, quickly recovered and tracked a contested pace three wide, moved closer nearing the quarter pole, lodged a four wide bid in mid stretch, dueled on his left lead, took command near the sixteenth marker and held sway in an extended drive. TEMPESTA DI NEVE prompted the pace two wide, inched closer after a half mile, gained a short lead in upper stretch, was overtaken near the sixteenth pole, dueled inside the winner and gave way grudgingly. IMMORTAL EYES set the pace inside, took pressure around the turn, dueled from upper stretch to mid stretch and faded late. SPRINGS ROAD, sluggish early, raced off the rail into the lane, angled wider past the three sixteenths pole and lacked a solid finish. PETCH saved ground and failed to respond.
