PRIVATE GAYLA was patiently rated off of a contested pace, advanced three to four wide entering the lane, surged clear in mid stretch and drew away under steady hand pressure. HOP ON IT saved ground under urging, chased the leaders around the turn, angled out in mid stretch and finished willingly to be clear for the place. NAGEM NAGEM NAGEM broke a bit awkwardly, was outrun early, angled wide in the lane and offered a belated run. J STAR bobbed at the break, dueled between rivals then weakened leaving the sixteenth pole. HEAVEN'S NOTEBOOK dueled along the rail to upper stretch then steadily gave way. NANARAE raced wide and failed to menace. WINNING WONDER prompted the pace three wide, drifted out four wide entering the lane then tired in upper stretch. FANTASTICA was outrun.
