ACCESS LOVE quickly reached contention along the inside after not breaking alertly, eased out around the turn to stalk the pace, rallied three wide to a short lead near mid stretch, dueled then edged clear late under a drive. CLASS RULES sprinted clear early, set a brisk pace inside, was collared nearing the furlong marker, dueled and stayed on well. LIVE THE DASH saved ground mid turn, angled out in upper stretch and closed willingly. ONE SMART GOLFER, jostled at the break, angled around the turn, made steady progress four wide in upper stretch then flattened out. OFFICIAL AFFAIR came out at the break into ONE SMART GOLFER, chased the pace three wide and came up empty. GOLDEN DOVE was steady when in close early. TEMPERANCE TIME forced the early pace three wide and faded. POWER IN TRUTH bobbled at the break, was in close early and failed to respond. I CAN DO IT, five wide into the lane, weakened.
