### Footnotes

KISS THE RING saved ground, found room along the rail through the stretch, closed and drove clear. SEA CURRENT , three wide entering the first turn, was forced in by MYUTHICAL HERO entering the turn, was caught in traffic near the half mile pole, raced three wide entering the stretch and closed between horses. GREAT GUSTO saved ground around the far turn, drifted out in upper stretch, gained a short lead in midstretch and weakened late. MYTHICAL HERO drifted wide approaching the first turn, drifted in on SEA CURRENT entering the turn, was five wide turning for home and flattened out. IMPISH VICTORY , bumped entering the first turn, raced six wide leaving the far turn, challenged for the lead in midstretch and weakened late. JOGGER chased the pace two wide, drifted four wide entering the stretch and tired. UNCONDITIONAL LOVE saved ground setting the pace, drifted out turning for home and gave way. FEDERAL HILL , checked in tight quarters entering the first turn, was not a factor. MOON IN , bumped entering the first turn, was not a factor. PORCUPINE , wide approaching the first turn, came in on rivals entering the turn and was outrun. MISTY SURPRISE broke slowly and was caught in traffic entering the first turn. An objection by the rider of FEDERAL HILL against SEA CURRENT for alleged interference entering the first turn was not allowed.
